#### WESTPORT FAIR HISTORY

The Westport Agricultural Fair was organized in 1955 by the joint effort of Harold S Wood (Principal of Westport High School) and Thomas J McGarr (Teacher of Vocational Agriculture).

The fair was to show the townspeople some of the activities that take place at the high school. The agricultural students and members of the young farmer program were responsible for the major promotion and organization of the program.

The first animal show was a large sheep show that included over 100 sheep. Other displays included bakery products, fashion shows, paintings, band concerts, games by the athletic dept, and the chicken BBQ served in the high school cafeteria. The first tractor pulls, replaced the horse pulling contest, and became a challenging event for local farmers. Our VP, Antone Oliveira, won the three-plow tractor class that very first year!

The fair's first scholarship recipients were William Donovan and Edward Sharples.

Many of our activities today are still based on the foundational activities started in 1955!
